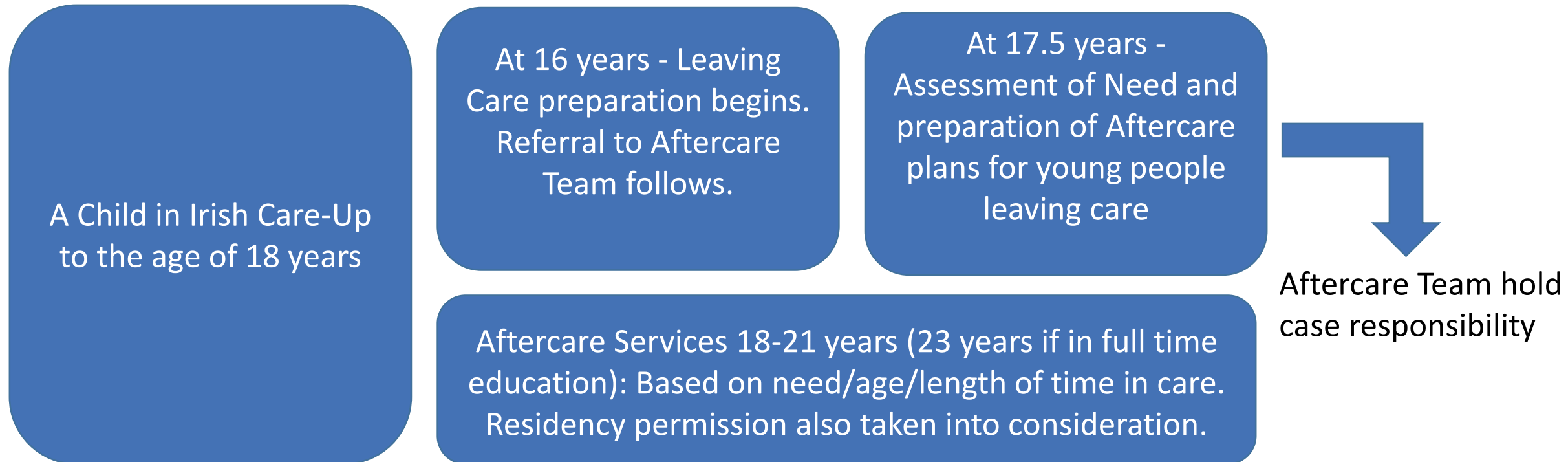


Support during and after transition to adulthood – Ireland (1)

Tusla Child and Family Agency is the statutory agency that holds responsibility for young people in care. Aftercare for those 18-21 years (23 years if in full time education).
